# A Missionary View

I am thankful for this time of year when things begin to spring back to life after the winter months. It is a time of refreshing and new beginnings. I pray for renewal for our churches and revival that might spring forth.

Believers around the world have been asked to pray for Ukraine. Countries have been asked to take a time slot. You are asked to take a minute in prayer for the

repentance of peoples, for the security of our countries, for the cessation of war and for God to guide the decisions of the leaders of the nations. The designated time for the United States is 9:00 pm. Every evening at 9:00 pm, stop and spend a minute in prayer.

If you or your church would like to make a donation to help with the refugees fleeing Ukraine, you may give through the Tennessee Baptist Convention (https://www.tnbaptist.org/) or through the Gibson Baptist Association: https://www.gbalife.org/online-giving.html). One hundred percent (100%) of your donations will be used to help the refugees.

I recently attended an information meeting with leaders of the Tennessee Baptist Mission Board and our Harvest Field Director of Missions. We were told about the change that is coming to West Tennessee later this year and in the future with the investment of Ford Motor Company. Ford is building a complex called BlueOval City, that will be constructed on a nearly 6 square-mile site in West Tennessee. Ford will build the next-generation electric F-Series pickups and advanced batteries. They will invest \$5.6 billion and create nearly 6,000 new jobs in Stanton, Tennessee. Gibson County will be impacted as well as other surrounding counties. Associations were challenged to begin now to plan on new church plants to accommodate the anticipated population growth. Let us pray now for the harvest field coming to our back door.


