

A Missionary View

We recently had an interest meeting about a **trip next year to Israel**. There were approximately 15-20 people in attendance with others expressing an interest that could not attend. We are working with the Yael Travel Agency and a lady by the name of Porit from Israel. The dates for the trip are **February 15-23, 2019.** 



I will have the quotation on the airline tickets and schedule in about 3 weeks. The estimated cost of the trip is \$3,700. This includes everything, hotel, meals, airline tickets, and two meals a day. You will be responsible for your own lunch meal each day. The price may be lower depending on the price of the airline tickets and if we have a large number going on the trip. The breakdown for payments is as follows: \$350 deposit due after we book our airline tickets. Six (6) months before the trip to Israel, you must pay 50% of the cost of the trip. Two (2) months before the trip, you must pay the remaining balance for the trip. If you are interested or know of anyone who might be, please contact me (rdstacy@gbalife.org or 731-414-9973). The trip is open to anyone.

Don't forget, this **Thursday evening, March 22, our associational Vacation Bible School clinic** will be held at Trenton **First Baptist Church. The conference begins at 6:00 pm**. The FREE training will be led by Homeland Security and will be held at the EMA building on April 2, 6:30 pm. The training is limited to two people from each church due to space limitations. You do not have to pre-register, simply attend the conference.
