A Missionary View

In 1981, (forty one years ago), I came to White Hall Baptist Church as pastor, and I began a special relationship with Gibson Baptist Association. Brother Ken Sparkman was the Director of Missions, he and Kathleen became special colleagues and friends. I became involved in the association serving on committees and served as Moderator. In 1982 Robert Bell and I went to what was then known as Upper Volta, Africa. At that time, my spiritual eyes were dramatically opened and my pastor heart was enlarged to a "global Kingdom heart." Little did I know during those days, and in that special relationship, God was continuing His preparation of our ministry for not only serving as pastor, but International Missionary and Director of Missions. In 1993 we were appointed by IMB to Romania. 1999 God brought us from His fields in Romania to serve in His fields here in Gibson County as Director Of Missions. We came with a specific calling and vision of mobilizing Gibson Baptist churches and volunteers in "hands on" missions involvement. During those years we did see many GBA churches and volunteers mobilized in international, national and local missions. During that time we saw God do amazing things in the association. The beginnings of CWJC, partnership with Birth Choice of Jackson, partnership missions in Romania and Mexico, Chain Saw Disaster Team, partnership with Mississippi River Ministry, Block Party Wagon. Then the Lord led us back to His international fields for 6 years in Costa Rica and Argentina. So now, 25 years as pastor; 12 years on the international mission field; 11 years as DOM (Gibson and Lawrence County); 6 years as Transition Interim in 5 churches. And now, here we are again in special relationship with Gibson County Baptists! I can testify, that no matter when, where, or what God has planned for us, He guides, He is always faithful, He provides. He enables and He empowers us for whatever His purpose is! I wouldn't take anything for my journey! Thank you Gibson Baptists for this "second blessing" allowing me to serve the churches, pastors, and the people during this transition time. I know that Brother Roger served GBA well these last 15 years. He and Penny will be greatly missed, and we continue to appreciate their service and Kingdom contributions in GBA. Grace and I stand ready to do all that we can to support, guide, and help. Partners again!
