Following the meeting, the women had a luncheon at the church. They meet every quarter to talk about and encourage mission work around the globe.







A Missionary View





I am excited to see our teams working and serving our churches. Here is a brief summary of what the teams have planned.

Strengthen Team: Our team is working to help churches in the area of revitalization. We are currently working with Fruitland and Truth to provide support and help. 




