Kenton FBC has served as a shelter for the American Red Cross and provided meals for the workers who are diligently helping with the removal of trees and restoration of services to the area. In speaking with our EMA Director and some city leaders in Kenton, we will seek to provide more direct help with disaster relief and recovery in the coming weeks. 
Merry Christmas and Happy New Year for those of you who may take time to read
