A Missionary View

I pray your church has a prosperous summer full of evangelistic opportunities. One of the key evangelistic tools God has given to us is Vacation Bible School. A large percentage of professions of faith and baptisms in the Southern Baptist Convention are a result of VBS. If your church needs help with conducting a VBS, let us know and we can help.

On September 11, there will be a “God & Country Rally” on the courthouse steps in Trenton. This will be in commemoration of 9/11. We will recognize our veterans, active duty, first responders, law enforcement, and others who serve and who have served our country and communities. Our special speaker for the evening will be Michael Imhof. Michael Imhof is a former US Navy Commander and Navy Seal. He has a tremendous testimony and will be sharing a special message. The rally will fall on a Wednesday evening and we are asking if your church would consider dismissing services to attend the rally at 6:31 PM. Bring a lawn chair and join in the celebration.

Remember that we are suggesting to our churches that Sunday, **July 28, be a day designated for a Wingo offering.** Some churches give monthly and we appreciate those who do. We would like to reach our goal this year of \$22,500. These funds help first-time mission volunteers with scholarships, and they also help those volunteers who feel led to go on more mission trips.

We will be taking a team to Brazil the week of September 16-24, to build a chapel for a church in Cascavel, Paraná. This is the city where we lived and served for many years. One of the churches is in need of a chapel for worship. Funds have been generously donated and the chapel is paid for. We need volunteers to join us in building the chapel. You do not need construction experience. Men and women, as well as high school students (age 16 and above) are welcome to join us on this trip. If interested, contact the GBA office.

We are still planning on our **2020 Israel trip.** I will be leading a group back to the **Holy Land** the week of February 27—March 7, 2020. Registration is now open. Please, e-mail (rdstacy@gbalife.org), text (731-414-9973) if you are interested or want more information. The cost is \$3,550 and you can make payments throughout the year.
