A Missionary View

A team of 9 volunteers will travel to Maringá, Brazil, May 24-June 1. We will work with the local association and a new church plant in the third largest city in the state of Paraná with a metropolitan population of over 750,000 residents. We also ask you to pray for our youth team traveling to Romania this summer, and the Ecuador team and Dyer First Baptist Church. Volunteers from FBC Humboldt will travel to Bangladesh. There will be other churches involved in mission trips in the coming months.

You may recall that at our annual association meeting last October, pastor Flávio Machado from Brazil was our guest preacher. We have worked with him several times with our volunteers in the city of Foz do Iguaçu. Last December, mission volunteers did evangelism and discipleship to help him plant a new church in Foz do Iguaçu. Pastor Flávio serves as a missionary of the state convention. Pastor Flávio sent a letter to the pastors and churches of GBA asking churches to prayerfully consider a love offering to help him and the Paraná Baptist Convention purchase land for the new church at a cost of about \$31,000. The Brazilian Baptist men will donate the building materials and build the building. He has also invited the GBA pastors to participate in revivals across the city in the churches in October. We have two or three pastors who have already expressed an interest in this trip. This is an exciting opportunity to partner with pastor Flávio and the Paraná Baptist Convention in this new church plant. We have three Wingo scholarships available for pastors who meet the qualifications on a first come first serve basis. With Wingo funds available to these three pastors, each one would receive \$1,400 to help pay for their trip to Brazil. Pastors interested should contact the GBA office.

The GBA Youth Rally was held on April 11 at Dyer FBC with seventy-five attending. There was one (1) profession of faith. I want to encourage more of our youth pastors/leaders to become involved in these monthly planning meetings and support the youth rallies. The annual See You At The Pole Rally will be September 20 in Trenton.




