A Missionary View

At our Executive Board meeting on February 7th, I informed the board that I will be retiring. I said that I would give them a date at the upcoming meeting on Monday night, April 25th. I have had many people ask me when my retirement date will be. I have prayed and sought God's will on this matter, and I will provide the timeframe at the board meeting.

Many of you know that Penny and I served in Brazil and Ukraine with the International Mission Board. We were the first IMB missionaries to serve in western Ukraine. We lived in the city of L'viv where you are seeing many journalists reporting on the war. Our hearts are broken for the people, pastors, and churches. Pray with us for God's protection and for the spread of the gospel in Europe.

Some have asked how they can make a donation to help with the refugees fleeing Ukraine. You may give through the Tennessee Baptist Convention (https://www.tnbaptist.org/) or through the Gibson Baptist Association: https://www.gbalife.org/online-giving.html).

We are preparing for an influx of people moving into our area due to BlueOval City (Ford Motor company) in the Brownsville area. There is a need for several Hispanic church plants on the horizon. On Sunday evening, April 10th, Fruitland Baptist Church voted to be a sponsoring church for a new Hispanic work. They have great facilities they are going to share with this new work. I met recently with Bro. Andy King, pastor of Fruitland, William Burton, language mission's specialist TBC, and Pastor Daniel the Hispanic Harvest field specialist with TBC. Gibson Baptist Association will be a part of this new work as we lend our prayers and support to the new church plant.

There will be a very important and helpful training conference lead by the Tennessee Baptist Convention entitled "Understanding, Reaching, and Sending 20-40-year-olds" with the gospel. This is a joint training conference with the Madison-Chester Baptist Association to be held on May 19, 6:00-8:30 pm, at North Jackson Baptist Church. Our churches must begin to address reaching Gen X and Millennials. This conference will help address this urgent need.

I want to thank Bro. Shawn Allred for serving as our VBS Director this year. We had a very good and successful VBS Training Conference on April 7. Also, I want to thank Rhonda Poore who is our Children's Bible Drill Director. She did an excellent job as well with our Bible Drills at White Hall Baptist Church.

Our **Block Party Wagon** has been completely refurbished and is ready for ministry. Charles King completely renovated our BPW. We have a new popcorn popper and a new bouncy house (jumper). 




