#### **A Missionary View**

With funds given to GBA due to the transition of the former "Connect" church, to the "Elevate" church, we have repaved our parking lot and are in the process of constructing a 24'X24' shed (with help from volunteers) for our Block Party trailer and our Disaster/Ministry Trailer. Additionally, with the remaining funds in this account, we are planning to renovate and update the GBA sign in front of our property.

As the previous effort to begin a Hispanic initiative did not develop, we are now in the process of praying and pursuing a new Hispanic possibility, in partnership with TBMB, The Church at Sugar Creek, and Fruitland Baptist Church. Thanks for praying and supporting this effort!

As, you may remember, the Disaster Trailer had been stolen from our property with our DR chain saws and equipment inside the trailer. Later, the trailer was recovered, but the equipment was never recovered. The trailer has been empty since that time. We are in the process of re-equipping the trailer. Our discussion is that we would utilize the trailer for a dual purpose, DR equipment (i.e. chain saws, generator, tarps, etc.), and Project/Ministry equipment (i.e. shovels, rakes, ladders, power saws, saw horses, small project equipment, etc.). Thus, we will be equipped with DR and Ministry Project items. The trailer would be available to our churches for projects like "fix up," ramp construction, painting, yard projects, gutter cleaning, for ministry projects organized by youth groups, men's ministry, etc. We already have some of the equipment and we will be gathering other items soon. We will be working on guidelines and requirements for use of the DR & Ministry Trailer.

Together we have loved, worshipped and served our Lord! Together we have loved, nurtured, and served people in our neighborhood, community, state and around the world in the name of Jesus Christ! Together we have developed and supported leaders with Evangelism Training, Deacons Meeting, Pastor's Conference, Retreats & Fellowship, WOM and WMU! Together we have prayed for and ministered to young folks with VBS, Youth Night at the Fair, BCM ministry at Dyersburg State Community College, FCA "Fields of Faith" rally in Trenton. Together we are sending volunteer missionaries near and far with Gibson County Fair Ministry, GBA Missions Weekend, Wingo Funds and Volunteer Missions Banquet! Together we are nurturing and supporting Senior Adults! Together we are fighting to protect life and supporting our Birth Choice Ministry! 




