A Missionary View

We are in the final preparations for the upcoming **annual meeting of the Gibson Baptist Association**. The meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 28, at the New Hope Baptist Church in Dyer. Our mission speaker this year will be Pastor Douglas Xavier from Rio de Janeiro. Pastor Douglas will challenge you, with the preaching of the Word and through his mission experience. This will also be the 24th annual meeting for Dianne as our Ministry Specialist.

Our Personnel Committee of the Association has been meeting since Dianne's announcement of her retirement. We received resumes from very qualified candidates for the position and the committee prayerfully considered each one. I am pleased to announce that Grace Gentry from Newbern, TN has been hired as our new Ministry Specialist. She is a member of Newbern First Baptist Church and has served as their church secretary for a number of years. Grace will join us to begin her new journey with Gibson Baptist Association on January 6, 2020.

I want to thank our churches, pastors and individuals for contributions to the Wingo Offering this year. Our goal is \$22,500. I am happy to announce that we are only about \$700 short of our goal as we head into the annual meeting on Monday night, October 28. Usually we have to have a substantial offering during the annual meeting to try and meet our goal.

We will be taking a team of 12 pastors and 12 lay people to hold another crusade in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil the week of February 3—11, 2020. Through the Wingo funds we are able to give pastors a one-time scholarship of \$1,400. These funds are only for those who have never been on a International Mission Board trip with the GBA. For those pastors who have already used these special Wingo funds, we are able to offer a \$600 one-time scholarship for this trip to Rio in February. Our goal is to have 12 preachers and a minimum of 12 lay people to participate in this crusade in Rio. There will be an interest meeting for the February trip to Brazil on Thursday evening, November 7, 6:30 pm, at the GBA office.

We will have our annual **Pastors, Staff & Wives Christmas dinner on December 3,** at Salem Baptist Church, Trenton, at 6:00 pm. This will be a catered meal and we will need you to sign up in order to have an accurate head count. There is no cost for the meal, but we must pay for the meal if you do not show up. 
Christian Women's Job Corps/"Twice Blessed"
