Christian Women's Job Corps/"Twice Blessed"

We are very excited about the acquisition of a home for women coming out of incarceration. After the closing on August 13th, 11 men and women met at the home for a time of prayer and dedication. We anticipate having ladies in the home as early as November. However, there are many details to be worked out. If you or your SS class, WMU group, or youth group would like to be a part of this great work, please let me know. We will need a facility manager (house mother) and a couple of backup people as well as volunteers for transporting the girls, teaching, and mentoring. Also, please contact me if you would like to be involved in the maintenance and upkeep of the home.

Classes continue at the Gibson County Correctional Facility as well as at Twice Blessed. We have one graduate from the jail who has an appointment with a dentist in Jackson on September 16th for free dental work. Two other graduates are in line for dental work. This is all possible because of Dr. Bob Rouse in Jackson who established the Agape Smile ministry and allows us to refer women who have completed our program.

Twice Blessed, which we consider to be our mission field, continues to be very busy with requests for utility assistance, food and clothing assistance as well as frequent shoppers.
