

A Missionary View

The annual Deacons' Meetin' for deacons, pastors, staff and wives will be held at White Hall Baptist Church on Thursday evening, September 6. A free meal will be served from 5:30—6:25 pm. We have a team of ten (10) volunteers traveling to São Miguel do Iguaçu, Brazil, the week of September 10-18. We will work near the borders of Paraguay and Argentina with pastor Dilson Augusto Neto. We covet your prayer support as we travel and work in Brazil.

Join us for our next **Brazil mission trip to Rio de Janeiro!** We will work with Pastor Douglas Xavier in evangelism and discipleship. The dates of the trip are **November 26—December 4**. The estimated cost of the trip is \$2,000. Wingo funds are available to help reduce the cost by \$300 to \$400 per person. The deadline for registration for the trip is October 1. There will be an interest meeting for this trip on September 20 (Thursday), 6:30 pm. If you do not already have a passport, please apply now.

Remember to ask your church to give to the **Wingo offering** for missions. Our goal this year is \$22,500.00. We have until September 30th to meet our goal this year. Volunteers depend on the Wingo funds to help them serve on the mission field.

As I mentioned in last month's Vision, there is a new tax law that affects non-profit organizations and churches. The law deals with a tax for providing parking for employees of the church. I have contacted an attorney who deals in church law and he feels this law will be repealed or adjustments made so that churches are exempt. He stated that no regulations have been written to define the law at this time. The attorney feels we do not have anything to be worried about at this time.

We have reorganized the youth ministry of the GBA. The Strengthen Team has asked Bill Kisner, Milan FBC, Travis Ellis, Kenton FBC, and Keith Donaldson, Connect Church, to serve as the GBA Youth Ministry Team. The team has decided this year to encourage churches and students to pray for their school systems on September 26, and participate in the national observance of See You At The Pole. Due to the fact that this year the focus was on the GBA Youth Night at the Gibson County Fair, there will be no GBA rally this year for the SYATP.

There will be a Disaster Relief Training held at SugarCreek on Sunday evening, October 14. Registration will be from 4:30 – 5:00 pm. The training sessions will begin at 5:00 pm. The following courses will be offered: (1) Introduction to disaster relief, (2) Flood recovery, (3) Chainsaw operation & Safety. There is a \$36 registration fee for those seeking certification.

September kicks off the emphasis for the Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions. These funds support church revitalization, church planting, compassionate ministries and many more ministries.
