






**B&R** Day 2020 Sunday, August 23

**A Missionary View** 

This is an unusual summer for our churches and ministry. Covid-19 continues to ramp up and surge in the number of cases. Some of our churches returned to online worship services and some that had added additional services have cut those back to only a Sunday morning worship. A few of our churches have never ceased to have all of their regular services.

Last month I shared that we have face masks available for our

churches through the gracious gift of Tennessee Baptist Convention Disaster Relief. If your church would like to have some of the face masks, you may pick them up at the GBA office. We have plenty on hand to meet your needs.

Our Executive Board meeting will be on Monday evening, 7:00 pm, at the GBA office. We were unable to meet in April due to the lockdown. We will do our best to make this meeting as safe as possible. Each church is allowed two Executive Board members (the Pastor and one lay member). We are requesting that your church send only ONE member to the meeting. We will practice social distancing during the meeting. We are asking Executive Board members to wear a face mask (not mandatory). We will provide face masks for anyone who needs one for the meeting.

The GBA annual meeting is scheduled for October 26, 2020. Antioch Baptist Church will host our meeting. At this point we have planned for our regular schedule for the meeting. As we monitor the Covid-19 situation, these plans may need to change. One association in our area is already planning to not have an in-person annual meeting. We will keep you updated as we near the time of our annual meeting.

I want to thank our churches for taking an offering during July for the Wingo mission fund. If your church did not take an offering during July, would you still consider doing so to help us meet our goal of \$23,000? Wingo funds are used to help mission volunteers from our GBA churches serve at home and around the world in missions.

Due to Covid-19, our mission trips to Brazil have been suspended. As a result, one of the ministries we help in Rio is facing a real crisis. We work with Silvia Crespo who helps with our logistics. She has a tremendous ministry to street kids who literally have no home. These children do not even have birth certificates as they are "throwaways." Silvia contacted me for financial help to buy these children food. I asked volunteers who have been to Brazil to ask their churches to take an offering to feed over 120 children. We received to date \$5,581! If you or your church would like to help, you may send funds to GBA designated for Rio Children.


