BIRTHCHOICE Hey guys, did you hear about the new law banning most abortions in Texas? The good news is that it could affect many other states, including Tennessee! This fall when the Supreme Court hears the

abortion-related case from Mississippi - Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization - it could affect Roe v. Wade! And if Roe v. Wade were overturned, Tennessee's "trigger law" would ban abortion when a heartbeat is detected. There is a common myth that if Roe v. Wade were overturned, pro-life pregnancy centers likes ours won't be needed. But that's not the case. If a pregnant woman can't turn to an abortion clinic for help, where can they turn? Why to us, of course! We could be seeing hundreds of more clients per year.

God is doing some amazing things through Birth Choice! We have a second Mobile Clinic going out and 2 ultrasound rooms going in our Jackson Clinic. "We could use you in the battle for life"! If you have a heart to minister to women with God's Truth and Love come be a Client Advocate for Birth Choice. Last year, we saw more women and saw more babies saved at our Gibson County Clinic than ever before. Even if you don't live in Gibson County, would you consider volunteering here?
