A Missionary View

Our Executive Board met on July 27<sup>th</sup> for our regular meeting. One of the main topics of discussion was a contingency plan in case we could not hold our regular annual meeting on October 26, due to the Covid-19 pandemic. I would encourage you to still elect messengers and make plans as normal to attend the annual meeting. We will notify you if we have to enact our contingency plan.

#### Here is the motion and contingency plan that was adopted.

- The board desires to have the annual meeting, if possible, at its regular date, time, and place. October 26, 2020, at Antioch Baptist Church. If it is deemed, solely by the discretion of the GBA Leadership team, unfeasible or irresponsible to hold the annual meeting due to the ongoing pandemic of COVID 19, will trigger the following contingencies as deemed necessary.
- Hold a special Called Executive Board meeting to approve officers, committees, and team members for the new church year. The nominating committee will make its recommendations to the executive board for approval. The budget and finance committee will present a budget for approval to the executive board. This option gives the most significant opportunity for input, next to having the annual meeting, in the decision-making process.
- Deeming option 1 or 2 to be unfeasible or irresponsible and in the unlikely event the nominating committee and the budget finance committee are unable to provide recommendations for officers, committees, and team members, and budget the executive board has chosen to adopt the current budget for the new associational year, October 1, 2020-September 30, 2021, and approve the current officers, committees, and teams to serve for another year until the next annual meeting of the association.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, many of our churches have struggled with members not attending in-person services. This is leading some to face the prospect of closure. On July 26, Maranatha Baptist Church in Humboldt voted to close their doors and dissolve. Their attendance dropped off significantly and they could not maintain the ministry of the church. On August 9, Connect Baptist Church in Milan voted to merge with Elevate Church in Milan. Due to Covid-19, the church has not recovered and the prospects for growth and outreach were very limited in light of the situation. The property and church building will be in the name of Elevate Church as the two churches merge. Connect Church will be making a sizeable financial donation back to GBA in appreciation and gratitude for the support the association has given them.

Bro. Zach McCain has resigned FBC Rutherford. Bro. Steve Hemann has resigned Mt. Pisgah. Pray for our churches seeking a pastor: Avondale, Chapel Hill, Clear Creek, Fruitland, Idlewild, Laneview-Kenton, Milan FBC, Mt. Pisgah, Mt. Pleasant, and Rutherford FBC.
